**SCHEME OF EXAMINATION AND EVALUATION
FOR CLASSES VI to VIII (SESSION : 2021-22)**

- The subjects that each student will have to study are Hindi, English, Sanskrit, Mathematics, Science & Technology, Social Science & Naitik Shiksha (Hindi Medium).
 - In addition to the above mentioned subjects, the students will be offered other subjects such as General Knowledge, Art Education, ICT and Physical & Health Education.
 - There will be two examinations in an academic year - Half Yearly Examination & Annual Examination.
 - The question paper of each subject will be of 80 marks. There will be Internal Assessment of 20 marks that includes Unit Tests, Subject Enrichment Activity, Multiple Assessment and Portfolio Assignment.
 - There will be three Unit Test cycles for the testing of the main subjects.
 - G.K, Naitik Shiksha, ICT and Art & Craft will be tested in Half Yearly and in Main Examination only.

- The Unit Test of 25 Marks will be reduced to 5 to be included in the final assessment. Written exams will not be rescheduled in any case if the child is unable to appear for the same.
- In case of leave, a leave application / medical certificate has to be submitted to the class teacher positively.
- It is mandatory for a student to qualify Term 1 examination by scoring at least 25% marks in the written examination to be able to appear in Term II.
- The student is required to score minimum 85% marks in overall result and 'A' grade in the subsidiary subjects to be eligible for the Merit Award.

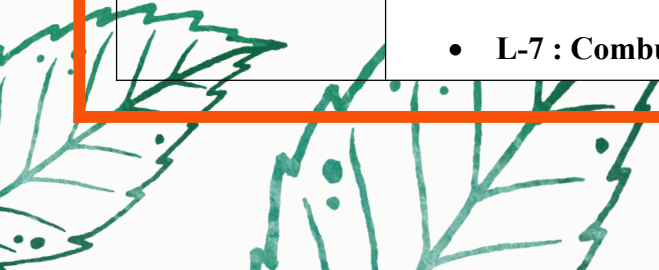

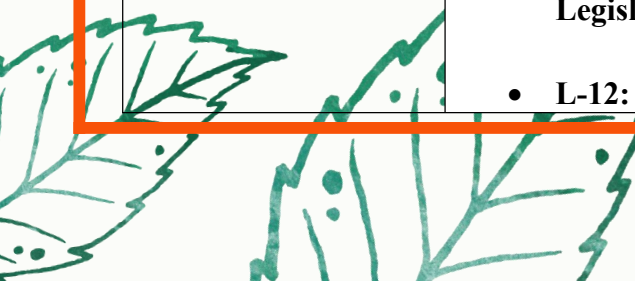
