- For classes III & IV
 - The Question Paper will be of 50 marks & the duration of Examination is 2 hours.
 - The Examination will be over at 1:00 p.m. & students' dispersal will be at 1:30 p.m.
- For class V
 - The Question Paper will be of 60 marks & the duration of Examination is 2 hours and 30 minutes.
 - The Examination will be over at 1:30 p.m. & students' dispersal will be at 1:35 p.m.
- For classes VI & VII
 - o The Question Paper will be of 80 marks & the duration of Examination is 3 hours.
 - o The Examination will be over at 2:00 p.m. & students' dispersal will be at 2:15 p.m.
- Students are not allowed to carry electronic items like digital / smart watch, mobile phone etc.
- Students need to carry their own stationery, water bottle and lunch. Sharing is strictly prohibited during examination.
- Students must report in time. No late comers will be allowed to sit in the Examination.
- Parents must pick and drop their child on time. NO CHILD WILL BE ALLOWED TO STAY IN THE SCHOOL AFTER THE FIXED DISPERSAL TIME.
- The Answer Sheets of classes III & IV will be shown to the students along with their parents on Wednesday, 01 March 2023. Timings will be intimated later.
- The Answer Sheets of class V will be shown to the students along with their parents on Saturday, 04 March 2023. Timings will be intimated later.
- The Answer Sheets of classes VI & VII will be shown to the students along with their parents on Saturday, 11 March 2023. Timings will be intimated later.
- The Annual Examination Result will be announced on Wednesday, 29 March 2023. Timings will be intimated later.
- Examination Roll Numbers will be issued to the students. No child will be allowed to sit in the Examination Room without the same.
- > Parents who have not cleared the fee dues of their ward of Quarter 4 of this session are required to clear the same immediately.
